There will be three performances for children on the spectrum, for the following age groups on these dates:

**Wed 7 May, 11.30am (for age 3-4)**

**Fri 9 May, 12.15pm (for age 3-4)**

**Sun 11 May, 3.30pm (for age 5-7)**

Note: Ideally, children should bring their own white coloured t-shirt and light coloured trousers, to wear as this will make the light projections more effective.

A ticket for one child (including one or two accompanying carer/ parents) is £10.

The theatre may be able to provide a craft room for siblings, with supervising parent/ carers, but this has yet to be confirmed. Otherwise, the theatre is close to London Bridge station and moments from the river Thames, so there are lots of sightseeing opportunities nearby.
