Hertfordshire Easter HAPpy Camps

- ♦ Free HAPpy Camps are provided in Hertfordshire as part of the Government's Holiday Activity and Food Programme for children who receive *child benefits-related free school meals*. They offer free fun, food, and physical activity for children, meaning less for you to organise as a family. They can also free up a vital few hours over the holiday for you as a parent or carer, as children can attend camps without you.
- ♦ Special educational needs and disabilities (SEND): SEND-specific camps are available for children with higher support or more specialist needs. It's recommended that all parents fill in as much information as possible and read the different camp descriptions carefully to check they're suitable to help match your child with their perfect HAPpy Camp.
