School Travel Plan

Amwell View is working closely with Hertfordshire County Council to produce a Travel Plan. The aim of a Travel Plan is to offer practical measures to promote active, healthy, safe and sustainable travel to and from school. As part of this project we will be looking at the school's parking arrangements, signage, road safety, and gathering data on how pupils and staff travel to school. The data will help the working party produce objectives for the future.
